

Chemo Quilt #4 Rectangles Friendship Knot Quilters' Guild

Block size: 6" x 10" need 35

Half blocks: 6" x 5" need 7

Finished quilt size: 42" x 55"

Recommended for 2 1/2" strips (35 to 40)

To make a whole block:

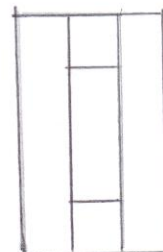
For the center color cut: one rectangle 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"

For the outside color cut: two 2 1/2" squares

two rectangles 2 1/2" x 10 1/2"

Sew the squares to each end of the center strip. Press seams.

Sew the 10 1/2" rectangles to each side of the center strip. Press.



The block should be 6 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished.

To make a half block:

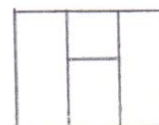
For the center color cut: one rectangle 2 1/2" x 3 1/2"

For the outside color cut: one 2 1/2" square

two rectangles 2 1/2" x 5 1/2"

Sew the square to one end of the center strip. Press seam.

Sew the 5 1/2" rectangles to each side of the center strip. Press.



To construct rows: Sew six whole blocks end to end (narrow ends).
Sew one half block at bottom of each row.

To construct top: Sew rows together alternating half blocks/whole blocks at tops of rows.

Need help basting your quilt sandwich or need quilting ideas? Bring your top, backing and batting to the July 19 meeting for help.

Recommended batting: Hobbs 80/20 Heirloom or other "drapey" product.
Not recommended: Warm and Natural
