

Board Meeting Minutes 5/5/10

In attendance: Karla Lynch/ President, Teresa Chappell/Treasurer, Ellen Simon/1st VP, Karen Brennan/2nd VP, Linda Pearce/Past President and Cass Bowen/Quilt Show Chair.

Discussion and decision was made on how to thank two quilt shops (Quilters Haven and Alma Sue's) to thank them for their generosity to the guild.

It was decided that Quilters Haven, who donates a sewing machine to the quilt show to raffle, will receive a full page ad in the quilt show program that will include a thank you from the guild. Also they will receive a full page ad in the newsletter in the February issue also including a thank you from the guild.

Alma Sue's quilt shop allowed the traditional quilt to be put on a frame in their shop and allowed members to quilt it over a period of weeks. They also contribute lots of fabric to the guild's Kidzquilts projects. To thank them the guild will place a color ad in the newsletter in November with a thank you from the guild.

Ellen made water bottle sleeves to thank the volunteer participants in the Health Fair April meeting.

Linda gave info on the web. Discussion took place on a variety of issues.

Teresa presented current financials.
