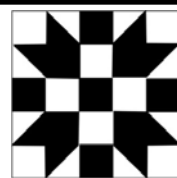

If you are interested in art quilts, I highly recommend you take a look at SAQA.com, (Studio Art Quilters Assn) this month to see the 280 quilts that are being auctioned to raise money for their programs and exhibitions. Two FKQG members have pieces in the auction – Sheri Cooper and Roberta Miller. The variety of artwork is amazing.

We will be opening registration for many of the 2011 classes at the October meeting. Complete schedules will be available at the registration table. January and March workshops are listed in this bulletin. Now, I don't want the traditional quilters out there to panic! The February workshop will be aimed at you; I just don't have the final details worked out yet. We will be adding the info to the website and the info will be available to all.

SMALL QUILT SILENT AUCTION

There will be a Small Quilt auction during the 2011 Quilt show, one on Friday and one on Saturday. At each of these auctions, quilts using many different techniques will be offered.

There will be hand and machine pieced jewels along with paper-pieced, appliquéd, felted and embellished beauties. Traditional patterned quilts, contemporary designs, and unique art quilts will increase the richness of these auctions. The only rule for the quilt maker is the perimeter of the little quilts will be no larger than 72 inches. Starting bids are \$20. unless otherwise stated by the quilt maker.

At the conclusion of the auctions, the winning bidders will be announced during the last hour of the show each day. Monies will be collected at that time and the winning bidders will take home a great quilt! If a successful bidder has already left the show they will be contacted and after payment is received the quilt will be mailed at the winner's expense.

Members can turn in their small quilts at each of Friendship Knot's guild meetings.
