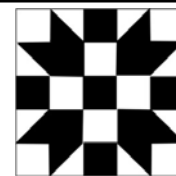

Lyric Kinard will be our speaker in January. Lyric is the author of *Art + Quilt*, a frequent contributor to *Quilting Arts Magazine* and has appeared on *Quilting Arts TV*. Her two classes are designed to teach the basics of putting "art" into your quilts.

Pamela Allen (a Canadian) has been forced to cancel her visit to Sarasota. Seems the U.S. government will not permit her to teach in the States. For those of you who paid for her classes, you can transfer your registration to another class or request a refund.

Nancy Mahoney, or Palm Coast, FL, will replace Pam. Nancy is the author of nine books, has designed five fabric collections, created seventy-five patterns for fabric companies, and has been published in over eighty magazines. She was originally contracted to visit the guild in January 2012 and luckily was available for the March opening.

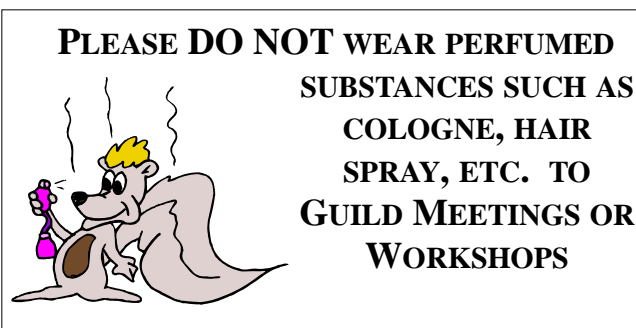

A NEW AND DIFFERENT COTTAGE GROUP—STITCH AND CHAT

Cancer is an ugly word, but we have many wonderful local resources. One very dear to me is the Cancer Support Community (formerly The Wellness Community of Southwest Florida) which recently relocated to a beautiful five-acre campus in Lakewood Ranch. Website: www.cancersupportsuncoast.org.

The Cancer Support Community (CSC) offers support, education and hope to cancer patients and their families. All of the programs are free. There are professionally led support groups, educational workshops, nutrition and exercise programs and mind-body-spirit classes (relaxation, yoga and qigong). All programs are designed to help people affected by cancer learn vital skills that enable someone to regain control, reduce isolation and restore hope.

The CSC recognizes quilting as path to healing. The weekly quilters group is called "Stitch & Chat". It offers a place to come together to socialize and de-stress. This cottage group is open to anyone with a history of cancer or a caregiver. Stitch & Chat meets every Monday from 10:00 a.m. to noon (10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on the 2nd and 4th Mondays). You can bring your own work or participate in our projects. We are currently making heart shaped pillows for breast cancer patients. Other projects raise funds for CSC programs or are donated to other patients such as covers for personal journal notebooks and yoga bags.

I plan to be there on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of each month from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. We provide coffee, materials and even have several sewing machines. THIS IS A BIG MONTH!

As we've been telling you for months now,



January 17, 2011 is the Guild Meeting and the deadline for submitting your registrations for the quilts you plan to enter into the show. We have already reached our limit for king-size quilts (6). Please remember to indicate on the form if a pattern was used to make the quilt and in the description if a kit was used to make the quilt. Two 4x6 photos of the quilt need to accompany the registration along

with the registration fee. 2011 Guild memberships must be paid on or before this meeting date in order to enter a quilt in the show. 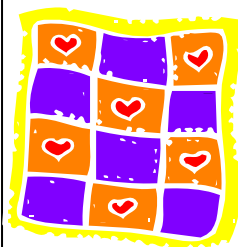

You will receive a simple form via email which you can submit to the chairs - Bev Wiberg (boutique), Nancy Adams (mini-quilts) and Donna Guess (blocks). You must complete the form yourself and they will sign the document. The Show Chair and her Committee can sign them too. There will be a limited number of forms available at the meeting for those few members who do not have computers.

We know the value of each item is in your time. However, the IRS does not allow for that deduction.
