The Art Quilter Unlimited Show will be held in Ft. Myers on January 21-22, 2011. It will be held in the Faith Presbyterian Church in Cape Coral.

Ann Greene announced that 106 members were in attendance, 4 new members, and 70 renewals. The total membership now is 275.

Cass Bowen presented the Chairwomen for the Quilt Show who proceeded to explain their particular committee and purpose. The Show will be held on March 11 & 12, 2011 at Robarts Arena. Donna Guess requested more quilt blocks for the auction. Betty Seeman will be giving 1 hour demonstrations during the show. She is asking for

volunteers to present demonstrations as well. Mary Jo Dranttel announced that there will be 2 quilts and 1 sewing machine raffled this year. The sewing machine is being donated by Quilt Haven. Bev Winberg will hold a workshop for Boutique items at Fruitville Library. Janet Wick will collect items for the Consignment Boutique on March 10th. The Guild will receive 20% of the sale price. Elva Farrel is still looking for sponsors for the Show book. Individuals and Businesses can buy space. Eva Winter is asking for volunteers to hostess in 2 hours shifts during the show. Carol Jenkins will handle the Admissions. Volunteers are asked to sign up for 2 hour shifts. Karen Brennan has and is doing a wonderful job with publicity. Ann Greene asked for more Challenge quilts. Beth Grindal asked for volunteers to iron sheets on the morning of set up. Tena Davis reminded all the membership must be paid up tonight in order to submit quilts to the show.

Ellen Simon announced that she will be teaching the February 21, 2011 class called "Tricks & Techniques: Medallion Quilt" for advanced beginners. Ellen announced that the Board made a decision to charge \$15.00 for half day classes and \$25.00 for full day classes for 2011. The Board also voted to continue with the Chemo Quilts as the charity activity for 2011. The size should be approximately 45"x60".

Show & Tell followed with another amazing show of talent.

Ellen introduced the speaker Lyric Kinard who presented her very interesting program.
