

Friendship Knot Quilters' Guild  
June 20, 2011

The regular meeting of the FKQG was opened at 7:00 PM by President Karla Lynch. Karla welcomed everyone to the meeting. She announced that the contributions to All Faith's Food Bank for the month of May were \$14.00.

The minutes for the April 18, 2011 regular meeting were unanimously approved by a voice vote on a motion by Mary Lewis with a second by Cass Bowen. Likewise the May 16, 2011 minutes were approved on a motion by Marcia Slocum with second by Jane Shannon. The April and May Treasures minutes will be presented with the June 20, 2011 minutes at the next regular meeting.

The newsletter deadline is June 25, 2011. All articles are to be sent to Lynne Minguez. A volunteer (or volunteers) is still needed to visit quilt shops in the area to sell advertising space in the newsletter.

Ann Greene reported that 70 people were present at this meeting. Two new members were introduced, 1 renewal membership giving a total membership of 259 for 2011.

Lynn Minguez and Joy Abbott are coordinating the UFO Camp to be held on July 7-10, 2011 at Dayspring Retreat. Thirty women have signed up to attend. Anyone interested in participating in games are asked to bring a jelly roll and 3 fat quarters ("that you can part with") for and "Unbelievable Fun Opening".

Show and Tell was once again amazing.

Jo Wienzski announced that 20 quilters attended the KidzQuilts work day at Fruitville Library. 399 quilts have been donated to Sarasota Memorial Hospital so far in 2011. The next work day will be held at SMH on July 12<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 AM until 12:30 PM at Fruitville Library.

Ellen Simon shared a Certificate of Appreciation given to FKQG that she and Dawn Moore received representing the Guild at a tea given by the hospital. So far this year 60 Chemo Quilts have been donated to the cancer patients at SMH.

The upcoming schedule for the meetings in July include a Trunk Show given by Jean Smith; October will feature JoAnn Jenson and November Anita Grossman Solomon will giving classes and a lecture.

Ellen then explained the “Ugly Fabric” challenge. The fabric packets included 6 “ugly” fabrics. Anything can be made with the fabrics that require at least 3 uglies. 75% of a quilt top must have at least 3 fabrics from the packet and putting one on the back does not count. The creations will be presented at the September meeting.

Ellen then introduced Debra Nielsen who presented a program on different kinds of batting.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:25 PM. The next meeting will be held on July 18, 2011. The next Board meeting will be held on July 6, 2011 with the location TBA.
