

**Friendship Knot Quilter's Guild**  
**Board Meeting**  
**January 5, 2011**

The members present: Karla Lynch, Catherine McNalley, Helen Lucas, Linda Pearce, Ellen Simon and Beth Grindal.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President, Karla Lynch.

Karla announced that Dawn Moore will meet with the County Council on February 8, 2011 to represent the Venice Guild concerning Quilt Month. She would like a representative from FKQG to join her.

Ellen Simon:

Anyone not able to make it to a class must call Pam Zeck to cancel. Pam will try to fill the spot with the waiting list.

Sharon Schamber charged an extra \$10.00 for the dyes at her class. This charge was not written into the contract. Ellen will contact Sharon about this discrepancy and report back to the Board.

Ellen will teach a class on Monday February 19, 2011 on accurate techniques for piecing and cutting troublesome unites commonly used in quilt blocks, as well as techniques that save you fabric. The project will be a medallion style, wall size consisting of a pieced center block, two pieced borders and three to four accent borders. Similar to Welcome to Florida, A quilt taught at Venice Quilters Guild will feature different "tricks of the trade". This quilt is a great warm-up for a round robin project.

Nancy Mahoney will fill in for Pamela Allen to teach the March class. She will teach Dot to Dot and Feathered Star. The allotment for her dinner will be \$20.00 for each of three days.

Ellen and Marlene Kurtz will purchase a projector for the Guild. They have researched extensively and have found the perfect projector and price for the needs of the Guild.

- Motion by Linda Pearce with second by Helen Lucas. The FKQG will continue with the Chemo Quilt charity project for the year of 2011.
