

Get Your Bias Strip Curve On

Supply List

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Tools & Equipment:

- o Sewing Machine with extension cord
- o **Sharp** sewing scissors – We will be using scissors a lot in this workshop – make sure to bring a good quality 7”- 8” pair of sewing shears with a sharp edge.
- o Hand sewing needles –thimble optional – just in case
- o Straight pins
- o Tailor’s chalk
- o Medium gray spool of thread
- o Rotary cutter and self-healing mat.

Materials:

- o Two to three $\frac{3}{4}$ yard selvage-to-selvage cuts of different valued fabrics – prints and/or solids. You will cut bias strips from this to share with the class.
- o Several large pieces of fabric for your curve shapes. Fat quarters, 18” x 22” work well as the minimum size. You may want to go larger.
- o Have a range of prints and solids, hues and values on hand to support your creative flow. Do not come with a coordinated color scheme. However don’t fret -- whatever you bring – will be enough to make do with.

If you miss the beginning of class I will be unable to bring you up to speed. If you need to leave a little early that is ok.
