### March 19, 2007 Meeting Minutes

President Tena Davis called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm, and welcomed all members and guests, who were enjoying party snacks and beverages provided in celebration of the very successful quilt show. Quilt Show chair Linda Nichols gave thanks and recognition to all who had worked on the show in some capacity.

Secretary's Report: Since the February minutes did not appear in the newsletter, they have been posted on the website, and paper copies were available at the meeting.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report was approved as published in the March Newsletter. Susan Ott reported that receipts are still being processed but it appears that the Guild will net around \$18000 from the quilt show.

Membership: Current membership is 256. In attendance were 126 members, 6 new members and 13 guests.

Education: Laura Cater-Woods classes have been restructured to emphasize design, and may be taken for one day or for all three days. Guild member Malia Bosch was recognized for having an article published in the Applique Society magazine. Cathy Washburn gave information on the UFO Quilt Camp to be held at Dayspring Retreat Center from July 13-15. Up to 25 residential members can participate for an inclusive cost of around \$160 each, depending on accommodation desired.

Program: Frieda Anderson presented an informative and entertaining slide show entitled "A Walk in the Woods with George," illustrating her quilts and techniques, and students from her classes showed their hand-dyed fabrics.
